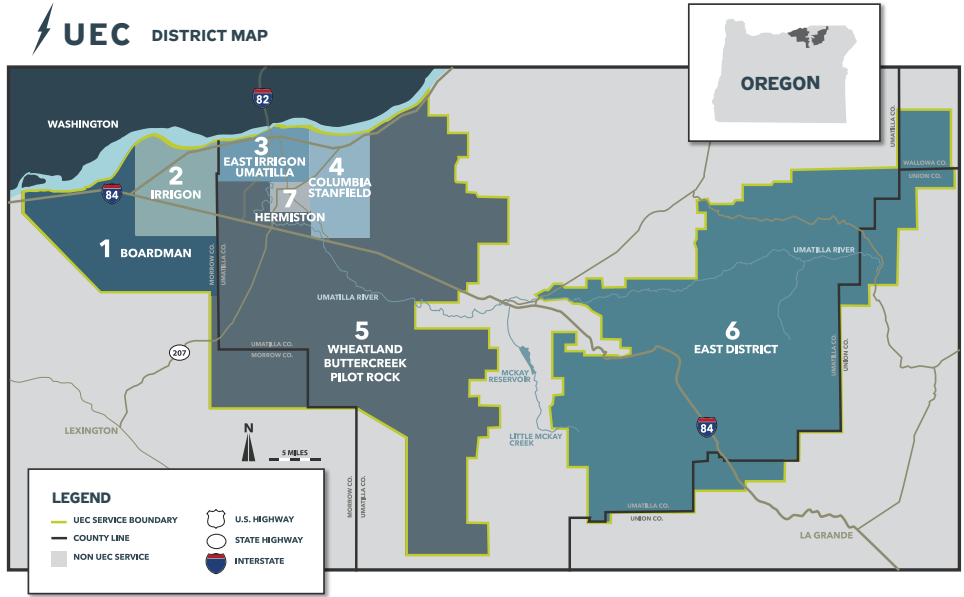

ABOUT UEC

Based in Hermiston, Ore., Umatilla Electric Cooperative (UEC) serves a large portion of the Columbia Basin of north-eastern Oregon. The cooperative's territory begins west of Boardman in Morrow County and covers much of rural Umatilla County surrounding the cities of Hermiston and Pendleton and into the Blue Mountains. Driven by growth in farming, food processing and industry, UEC has grown into the largest electric cooperative in the 10 western states in terms of power sales. UEC marked a record year of revenue and kilowatt-hour sales in 2016, with 1.8 billion kilowatt hours sold. Most importantly, UEC is a nonprofit corporation owned by the members it serves.

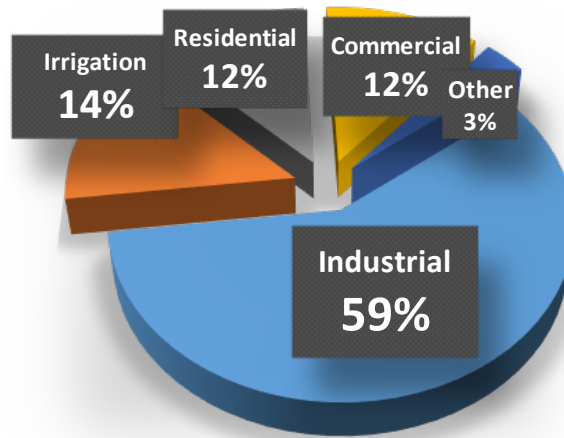
